School Dance Conduct and Appearance Code

- I. Students must present this signed permission form to be admitted to the dance.
- II. Students are required to attend school on the day of the dance to be eligible to attend the dance.
- III. Student behavior is expected to reflect Christian ethics and be in accordance with the religious and moral expectations of a Catholic school.

Conduct Code:

- ✓ Offensive language or obscene gestures are not allowed.
- ✓ No sexually suggestive dancing such as "grinding" and "twerking" or unsafe dancing as deemed by the administration or staff will be allowed.
- \checkmark No fighting or rough play is allowed.
- ✓ Disrespectable behavior toward any administrator, teacher, or chaperone is not allowed.
- \checkmark No outside food or drink may be brought into the dance.
- \checkmark No in and out privileges are allowed.

Appearance Code: Attire for the dance must be modest and age-appropriate as determined by the on-site administrator or designated representative.

Girls

- ✓ No backless, strapless, halter, spaghetti strap, camisole strap blouses or dresses may be worn.
- ✓ Dresses, skirts, or shorts must be of appropriate and modest length.
- \checkmark No midriff baring tops or pants may be worn.

Boys

- \checkmark No baggy-style attire.
- \checkmark Pants must be worn at waist.

Both Boys and Girls

- \checkmark Hats, bandanas, headbands, or sunglasses may not be worn.
- ✓ Inappropriate words, graphics, symbols, decorations, or chains are not allowed on clothing.
- \checkmark Purses and backpacks are not allowed.
- \checkmark No flip-flops may be worn.

The school reserves the right to remove any person who is in violation of the above standards of conduct and appearance from the dance and the student will not be entitled to any refund of any monies paid. Additional consequences may be issued by the administration at the student's home school site.
